When we receive your application we will arrange for a senior worker (a church leader who is associated with one of the partner agencies) to meet with you and discuss the entire process, including the initial Church Health Check. The combination of a set of standard questions, guided by an experienced external adviser, adds a measure of meaningful objectivity to assist realistic reflection and strategic planning. This initial discussion will outline associated costs and time commitments.

After the report (resulting from the Church Health Check) has been compiled, it will be presented to the leadership outlining various steps that could be taken to help the church develop from its current position. These could include specific leadership support/mentoring, working with another local fellowship or considering the appointment of people with the gifts to meet the challenges and opportunities identified. Generally we would recommend that an adviser be appointed to continue to walk with the church through this journey. It may even be possible that a part-time worker could be allocated to the church for a period of time, with some of the necessary funding made available to cover costs. At all stages the local church remains in control of the process.
